LEOS In Action Photo Contest (Digital) CRITERIA:

Leos from clubs in good standing can enter an original, unaltered, black-and white or color photo in the Leos in Action Photo Contest (Digital).

The Leos in Action refers to Leos participating in either a Leos service project/joint Lions & Leos service project or in a Leos/joint Lion & Leos fundraising project.

Leo Club can enter one (1) digital photo to the District Leo Chairperson in a single club activity showing Leos in Action (one entry in either service or fundraising, but not both)

All entries must be received by the District Leo Chairperson by May 11th, 2024.

The judges would be District Governor Elaine Luk, District Governor Elect Kevin Borde, and 1st District Governor Elect Teresa Ng. They will select the winner, 1st runner up and 2nd runner up. The result would be announced at the Leo Convention.

- 1. Digital Photos must be submitted in a printed 8x10 format in high resolution.
- 2. One entry per club.
- 3. Photos must be original and unaltered in any way. A photo may not be submitted twice. District Leo Chairperson reserves the right to reject photos not meeting contest criteria.
- 4. Each entry shall attached on a separate page, the following information:

 The name of the club(s) in the photo, the zone, the district, a short description of the purpose of the activity, the date, and the location.
- 5. Winners will be selected on originality, artistic merit, and portrayal of activity.
- 6. Additionally: Children may not be photographed without their legal guardian's permission. In any case, do not give the names of any children.
- 7. The Leos in Action activity must be identifiable as well as all Lions/Leos Clubs taking part.

Club Achievement 5-Minute Speech CRITERIA:

Highlighting One Current Year's Club Project is to be given for an oral presentation of an activity of the club.

- 1. The participant shall limit his or her presentation to that phase of the activity that has been completed during the current club year.
- 2. The time limit for the presentation is 5 minutes. A penalty of 5 points for each minute, or fraction thereof, shall be assessed against a speaker running over the 5-minute limit.
- 3. 25% is allowed for oral presentation, 75% is allowed for relative value of activity.
- 4. There will be 3 judges at the presentation and shall judge
 - a) the oral presentation, taking into consideration the attire professionism/use of effective body language of the speaker, presence, voice, methods employed, and the general effectiveness of the presentation. (25%)
 - b) the relative value of the activity, the nature of the activity, the service to the club itself, the service to the community, the size of the club, the effort required by the club, and the permanent benefits to the club and to the community keeping in mind that what may be of great service to one community might not be the same service to another community. (75%)
